Meet & Greet

Young Professionals from all over the state come together to kick off the IN-AWWA Annual Conference with a Meet & Greet event. In this social setting, YPs can meet and network with other YPs in the drinking water industry as well as IN-AWWA Section leaders. This event is not an official Conference event, so all YPs are encouraged to attend, regardless of whether or not they will be attending the Conference.

Fresh Ideas Poster Competition

The YP Committee sponsors the Fresh Ideas Poster Competition annually. This competition is open to YPs who work or attend an educational institute in the state of Indiana. Participants prepare a technical poster to display at the IN-AWWA Annual Conference. The top presentation will have the opportunity to present at the AWWA Annual Conference & Exposition to compete nationally.

YP Summit

The YP Summit is an annual event open to AWWA, WEF, and non-members. The YP Summit offers YPs a wide variety of professional development sessions built on career enhancement topics as well as an opportunity to network with others in the drinking water and wastewater industries throughout North America.

Technical Sessions
