Location Information

The golf outing will be held at **Eagle Creek Golf Club** in Indianapolis, Indiana. The golf format will be a scramble with a 10:00 a.m. shotgun start. If you want to participate in the putting contest, the contest begins at 4:30 p.m. Please fill out the registration form - for those of you who select a golf level sponsorship we will use your company name to slot your foursome. As always, it is first come, first served or the first payment to arrive gets the spot. Please remember that we do accept credit cards (Amex, Discover, Master Card and Visa) so you can fax or email your payment and forms in (this will definitely move you to the front of the line). When you arrive (for those of you who chose a golf level sponsorship) on the 30th, all you'll have to do is check in. NO tickets and NO hassles because everything is included!! **Registrations must be received and paid by Monday, July 7th, in order to reserve your spot. We are limited to 240 golfers for this event so get your registration in early.**

DIRECTIONS:

Eagle Creek Golf Club – 8802 W. 56th St. (317) 297-3366

Southbound I-465 traffic options: a) Exit at 38th Street, turn left and then left again to I-465 north and exit 56th Street. b) Take I-65 South to the Lafayette Road Exit, turn left at the end of the ramp and left again at 56th Street. Then take 56th Street West for approximately 3 miles to the first stoplight west of the reservoir. c) Exit at 71st Street, turn right and then turn left on to Shanghi Road. Then you will need to turn left onto Lafayette Road and take it to 56th Street, where you will turn right. Take 56th Street west for approximately 5 miles to the first stoplight west of Eagle Creek Reservoir.

Northbound I-465 or Airport Traffic: Exit I-465 at the 56th Street Exit and turn left. Then take 56th Street West for approximately 3 miles to the stoplight west of the reservoir. **Downtown Traffic:** Use I-65 to the Lafayette Road Exit and turn right. Then turn left on to 56th Street, which is your 2nd stoplight. Follow 56th Street for about 5 miles until you see our sign at the first stoplight west of Eagle Creek Reservoir.
