The Certified Plant Wastewater Treatment Operator routinely interfaces with the environmental area manager and the environmental team to establish and modify relevant operating procedures and to ensure adherence proactively and reactively to those procedures

Summary of Responsibilities:

- Work is performed with considerable independence under the direction of the division manager air, gas and water (AGW)
- Responsible for all technical aspects of wastewater treatment operations and compliance with state and federal operating regulations
- Responsible for all aspects of sampling, monitoring, and testing required to maintain compliance with federal, state and local regulations governing the wastewater treatment process, and storm water and sludge management under all weather conditions
- Submits all required compliance reports for municipal and industrial facility NPDES Permits as a certified operator in charge
- Works closely with AGW operations and maintenance personnel to ensure wastewater treatment equipment functionality and reliability
- Oversees upstream and downstream facilities as they pertain to water treatment including lake water intakes (LWPS#1 and LWPS#2), blast furnace closed water pumping station (BFCWPS), reclamation services building (RSB), wastewater pumping stations (WWPS#1 and WWPS#2), secondary waste treatment plant (SWTP), sanitary sewage treatment plant (SSTP), polishing lagoons, outfalls, and connecting sewer and storm water transport systems
- Provides guidance and recommendations regarding the installation, maintenance and repair of all water treatment-related facilities
- Conducts the necessary weekend checks of the water treatment facilities on a rotating basis
- On call to respond to emergencies and breakdowns at the plant and pump stations
- Performs all work in conformance to Cleveland Cliffs Occupational Safety and Health regulations under all weather conditions
- Maintains open communications with the management and bargaining unit employees regarding the treatment process and pump stations operation and malfunctions, as well as make recommendations for repairs and improvements to these systems
- As and when needed, act as the department's representative to the public

Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor of Science Degree field from an accredited educational institution in a technical discipline or commensurate experience operating a wastewater treatment facility
- Possess an Indiana Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator's Class D and Class II license or ability to obtain within 3 months of employment
- Maintain a State of Indiana driver's license in good standing
- Excellent verbal and written communications skills
- Works well in a team-oriented work environment

Preferred Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in chemistry, biology or engineering
- 5 years experience as certified Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator
